Thank you to the support of the volunteers. We are helping to increase the Facebook presence with the help of Ms. Johnston. Yearbook pictures are being taken in the classes. Kona Ice was at TTE on Friday and all went well and the kids enjoyed. The Timberwolf prize will happen on Thursday, February 4th and will have a special art project with Dr. Draper during the day. The staff vaccination date has been moved up. Staff should be receiving email in the next few weeks to schedule their dates. A purchase request has come to light from staff. The school's die cutter is in need of replacement and will cost approximately \$5k. Picture retakes for kids who were out on quarantine will need to contact Dorian directly to schedule. The retake pictures will still be included in the yearbook. We have only had one quarantined class since returning in January. The district is meeting Tuesday night to discuss middle and high school returning to the classroom, but elementary should not be impacted. As quarantines continue, no webcams will be in elementary classrooms. The dissection project for 5th grade is not happening this year. Ms. Radke will look into the opportunity for kids to do the project at home. A question was asked about volunteer parent opportunities to help at the school, even if it was outside on the playground. At this point, visitors and parents are not allowed in the school. Valentine's Day will be celebrated in class on February 11. SAC meeting is scheduled for February 10th.
